Almost 3,800 active women in the Trade and Industry Register

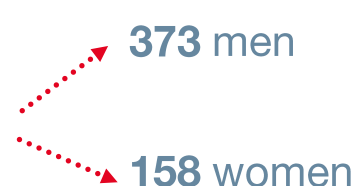


13,514 people of which **3,781** women in activity within boards of directors and decision-making bodies of the economic agents in the Trade and Industry Register of Monaco

50.9 years old on average (53.2 for men)



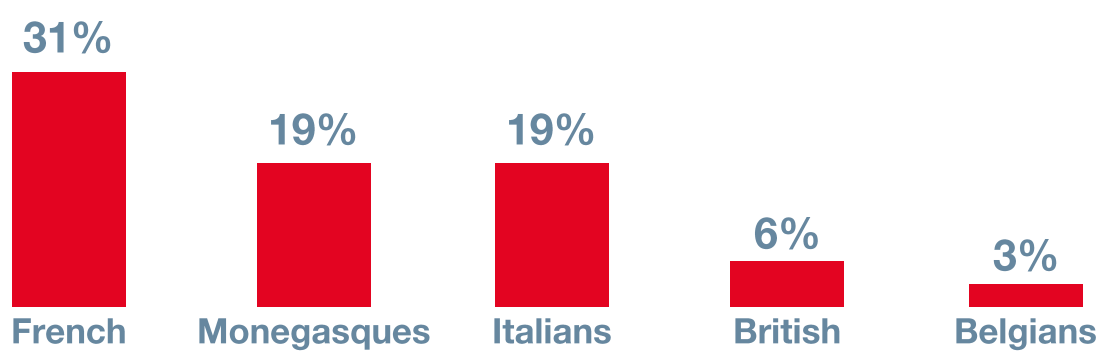
69% live in the Principality
